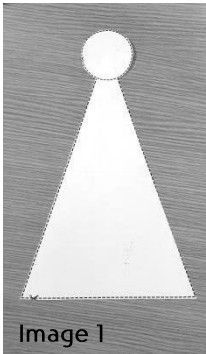

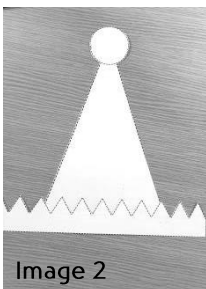
Use the template as a guide to create the shapes on coloured card or print the template on plain or coloured paper. You will also need glue, double-sided tape, cellotape or a stapler and staples to attach the pieces together.

To make the elf hat:

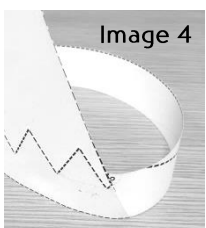


1. Cut out the seven pieces.

2. Attach the hat bobble (no.2) to the top of the hat (no.1) so it looks like image 1.



3. Attach the head band front (no.3a) along the bottom of the hat so it looks like image 2 and cut off any excess left over at each end.



4. Now, decorate your hat, making it your own!



5. Attach head band back (no.3b) to one side of the front head band. This next step will require another pair of hands! Ask someone to wrap the head band round the back of your head to meet the other side of the front head band so it fits securely on your head and attach. You may need to use the head band extension (no.3c). Images 3, 4 and 5 show each step.

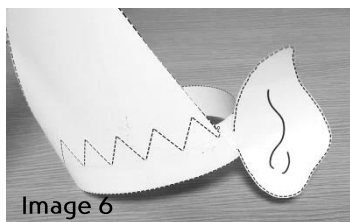

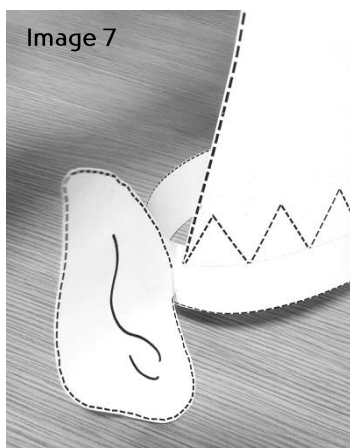

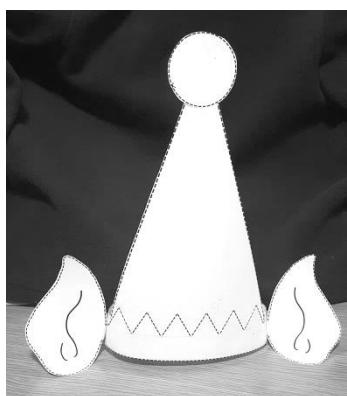

6. Now it's time to attach the ears! Fold the tabs of each ear following the dotted lines. Attach right ear (no.4) to the right hand-side of the head band.



7. Repeat with the left ear (no.5) on the left hand-side.



8. You have now finished your #ElfYourself Hat!
